## *Top Tips on Saving Energy*



There are lots of ways to save energy at home. Most cost nothing, some cost a little, but together they can save you money on your energy bills.

- 1 Close curtains at dusk to keep the heat in, open internal doors to sunny rooms to let the warmth travel through your home.
- 2 Avoid opening windows or doors, turn down the heating to cool a room.
- 3 Remove furniture that is in front of heaters or radiators, it blocks the heat from the rest of the room.
- 4 Check that your hot water tank thermostat is set no higher than 60°C.
- 5 Lag your hot water tank with an 80mm jacket.
- 6 Never put hot/warm food straight into the fridge/freezer.
- 7 When using a kettle only fill it with as much water as you need.
- 8 Turn TV's/video recorders/stereos off properly when not in use - leaving them on standby wastes energy.
