- **Develop markets for recyclate**
- **Identify and facilitate innovative projects and technologies for waste reduction, collection, and processing**
- **Provide top quality business support to help the reprocessing sector in Wales to grow**
- **Disseminate UK and International 'best practice'**
- **Facilitate inclusion of a 'Welsh dimension' in National Waste strategy**

Supporting the Reprocessing Sector in Wales:

- **Wales HQ in Cardiff Bay, all-Wales team of Account Managers**
- **Programmes integrated with Envirowise, CEW, Eco Design Centre, DE&T.**
- **'Standard' national support schemes for reprocessing sector (adaptation for Wales)**
- **New 'continuous' grant schemes for Wales**
- **Capital funding product for infrastructure (more flexible in Wales – multi call, multi stream)**

Capital Support Programme 2008 - 2011:

- **DESH Waste Strategy priorities – C&D Waste, Mixed Plastics.....Food Waste using AD**
- **Previous competitions including food waste via AD – 4 projects offered support**
- **Bank Farm Expansion**
- **Major food manufacture – SE Wales**
- **Abattoir – N Wales**
- **Abattoir waste - off site, mid Wales**

Capital Support Programme 2008 - 2011:

- **Competitive, but 'multi call' over 3 years**
- **Up to 30% 'intervention rate' (more with Convergence Funds.....hopefully!)**
- **Launch imminent**
- **Waste has to be minimum of 60% 'C&I'**
- **Integrated support with UoG 'Centre of Excellence'**

Capital Support Programme 2008 - 2011:

- **Launch – November 2008**
- **'Call' dates (applications in) – Jan 2009; July 2009; Jan 2010**
- **Assessment and panel decisions – March 09, Sept 09, March 10**
- **6 month period to contract (typically)**
- **Project delivery and final payment by March 2011**

Evaluation Criteria:

- **Overall value for money offered**
- Financial robustness of the proposal
- Quality of the design of project facility
- Effective arrangements for the facility outputs
- Effective arrangements for sourcing inputs
- Applicants ability to deliver the project
- Corporate environmental commitment & overall environmental impact of the new facility
- Corporate commitment to Health & Safety
