Cleeve School is a Mixed Comprehensive school based on the outskirts of Cheltenham in Gloucestershire. The school caters for over 1500 students between the ages of 11 and 18. Cleeve School has specialist status in three areas: Leadership, Languages and Technology.

The school site accommodates multiple buildings dating between the 1960s and the present day. The site is undergoing extensive redevelopment culminating in a new Science, ICT and Learning Skills block which opened in October 2008. The school joined the YEP! Project to support the specialist subjects and ensure the school community maximises the benefits of the Energy Efficiency measures in the new buildings.

The Cleeve School Energy Management Team (SEMT) initially began as a team of 15 students in Years 10 and 12. The SEMT took an active role in the YEP! Project and delivered a confident speech as Sustainability Officers at the Threatened Islands Debate at the Council Chambers in October 2008. The SEMT monitor the school's energy use which is supplied by both gas and electricity and have conducted an Energy Survey of the site. Following the survey report the SEMT have begun to implement an energy efficiency campaign to encourage the school community to change its energy behaviour. The team have recently recruited additional students throughout Years 7 & 8 to assist with their campaign which is proving to be a real success.
