Rednock School is a Mixed Comprehensive school based in Dursely, Gloucestershire. The school has specialist Science status and caters for over 1300 students between the ages of 11 and 18.

When YEP! was initially implemented at Redbock the school site accommodated multiple buildings dating pre-1919 to the present day. The Rednock School Energy Management Team (SEMT) made up of 12 students in Years 10 and 12, delivered an excellent speech as Environmental Health Officers at the Threatened Islands Debate at the Council Chambers in October 2008 and argued their case effectively. They SEMT also monitored the school's energy use which was supplied by both gas and electricity and have conducted an Energy Survey of the site.

In 2009 a brand new facility based on sustainable build principles was opened. Now that the school community has settled into the new site the SEMT will be developing the YEP! Project in order to support the Specialist Science Status activities and to ensure Energy Efficient measures continue to be implemented and energy efficient behaviours are maintained.
