Stroud High School is a Girl's Grammar school based in Stroud, Gloucestershire. The nature of the school means that students often commute from areas such as Cirencester and Cheltenham to attend school. The school has specialist status in Science and caters for over 900 students between the ages of 11 and 18.

The school site contains a multiple buildings of various construction dates, beginning before 1919. A large extension to the main school building was opened in September 2006 and accommodates the majority of teaching rooms. Stroud High School joined the YEP! Project as they are keen to make progress towards becoming a Sustainable School and aim to provide a range of opportunities for students to develop Work Related Learning.

The Stroud High School Energy Management Team (SEMT) is made up of 24 students in Years 10, 12 and 13. The SEMT are passionate about making a difference in school and have produced a high quality energy survey report. The group represented Energy Advisors at the Threatened Islands Debate and gave a well thought-out speech and posed challenging questions to their opponents. Following the recommendations made in their survey report the SEMT are taking forward their ideas, implemented an energy efficiency campaign within the school to encourage staff and students to change their energy behaviours.
