Tewkesbury School is a mixed comprehensive secondary school located in the town of Tewkesbury, Gloucestershire. The school caters for over 1700 students aged between 11 and 18. Tewkesbury School has specialist status in Technology and Modern Foreign Languages which has enabled the school to enhance the curriculum and facilities.

The school site accommodates multiple buildings, generally dating between 1945 and the 1976. Tewkesbury School has a wide variety of reasons for joining the YEP! Project including a commitment to becoming a Sustainable School and broadening the skills of the students.

The Tewkesbury School Energy Management Team (SEMT) is made up of 15 students in Years 10 and 12. The SEMT are well motivated and delivered an excellently prepared speech as Architects at the Threatened Islands Debate. The SEMT actively monitor the energy use in the school and have conducted a School Energy Survey. As a result of YEP! work at Tewkesbury SWEA have successfully seized the opportunity to build on the energy saving work in the DCSF funded 'Towards Zero Carbon School' project. This has drawn in substantial capital funding based on the recommendations made by the SEMT, who will now take an active role in this exciting project!
